RESOLUTION NO. SP- **6988**, S-2017

A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE SINCEREST CONGRATULATIONS AND COMMENDATIONS OF THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, THE CITY VICE MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, AND THE HONORABLE MEMBERS THE 20TH QUEZON CITY COUNCIL TO BARANGAY SAN BARTOLOME, QUEZON CITY FOR BEING AWARDED AS THE SECOND RUNNER-UP IN THE 2015 NATIONAL LUPON TAGAPAMAYAPA INCENTIVE AWARDS FOR HIGHLY URBANIZED CITIES.

WHEREAS, Section 399 (a) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as "The Local Government Code of 1991," provides that "there is hereby created in each Barangay a Lupon Tagapamayapa, hereinafter referred to as the Lupon, composed of the Punong Barangay, as chairman and ten (10) to twenty (20) members." It is an administrative body created by law to operationalize the barangay justice system which is better known as the Katarungang Pambarangay;


WHEREAS, the *Lupong Tagapamayapa Incentives Awards (LTIA)* was established pursuant to Section 406 (b) of Republic Act No. 7160 which mandates the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) to grant economic and other incentives to *Lupong Tagapamayapa* for their outstanding contributions to attain the objectives of the *Katarungang Pambarangay*. It was established in 1997 as a means to institutionalize a system of granting economic benefits and other incentives to the *Lupong Tagapamayapa* that demonstrates exemplary performance in settling disputes at the grassroots level. The performance and accomplishments of the *Lupons* were evaluated by committees organized at the regional, provincial and municipal levels on the basis of: a) efficiency of operations; b) effectiveness in securing the *Katarungang Pambarangay* objectives and c) creativity and resourcefulness of mediators;

WHEREAS, a National Awards Committee was in charge of the 2015 national validation conducted earlier in the year for the LTIA. The Committee is composed of officials from the DILG, Department of Justice (DOJ), Supreme Court (SC), National Peace and Order Council (NPOC), *Liga ng mga Barangay (LnB)* and representatives from two non-government organizations;

WHEREAS, last October 27, 2016, during the 25th Anniversary of the enactment of Republic Act No. 7160, the DILG has cited 300 local government units for exhibiting good governance. A total of 306 local government units were conferred the Seal of Good Local Governance, while four barangays earned the Outstanding *Lupong Tagapamayapa* award, with eight runner-ups;

WHEREAS, *Barangay San Bartolome, Quezon City* was hailed as the Best *Lupon* for the National Capital Region (NCR) and represented the region in the National Level of the LTIA. DILG Secretary Ismael Sueno, together with DILG-NCR Regional Director Maria Lourdes Agustin and Assistant Regional Director Juan Jovian Ingeniero, awarded the *lupon* members of *Barangay San Bartolome, Quezon City*, headed by *Punong Barangay Lamberto Pascual*, as the second best *Lupon Tagapamayapa* in the country;

WHEREAS, the special recognition awarded to *Barangay San Bartolome, Quezon City* only shows that it is committed and dedicated in the performance of their duties and responsibilities in mediating and conciliating conflicts within their community;




WHEREAS, it is only fitting and proper to commend Barangay San Bartolome, Quezon City for being the second best Lupon Tagapamayapa in the country.


NOW, THEREFORE,
