A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO PROCURE SIX (6) UNITS OF MOTORIZED VEHICLE, TO BE DONATED AND UTILIZED BY THE QUEZON CITY POLICE DISTRICT (QCPD), FOR THE EFFECTIVE IMPLEMENTATION OF THEIR OPERATIONS AND LAW ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITIES, SUBJECT TO EXISTING LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS, the donation of the said motor vehicles for the QCPD are necessary to ensure their mobility and efficient response time, inspire the police force and as well as further show the Quezon City Government's support for the maintenance of peace, and order;

WHEREAS, Mayor Herbert M. Bautista is authorized to donate Six (6) units of Motorized Vehicle to the Quezon City Police District (QCPD), for the effective implementation of their operations and law enforcement activities, subject to laws, rules and regulations,
