A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT, THROUGH THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO PURCHASE TWO (2) UNITS OF MOTOR VEHICLES INTENDED FOR MONITORING OF PROGRAMS AND PROJECTS UNDER THE 2017 ANNUAL BUDGET OF QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, Section 455 (b) (1) (vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991", states that, "The City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations, and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance";


WHEREAS, the Commission on Audit (COA) issued Audit Observation Memorandum 2014-11-C, S-2013, "requiring the City

Council to give prior authorization to the City Mayor before any expenses/disbursements charged against a lump sum appropriation can be made" citing the case of Hon. Gabriel Quisumbing vs. Hon. Gwendolyn F. Garcia (GR No. 175527) decided by the Supreme Court as basis;

WHEREAS, the two (2) All-Purpose Vehicle (APV) are to be used as service vehicle of the personnel of District VI Dental Division, and District VI District Office of the Quezon City Health Department;




NOW, THEREFORE,
