A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE FULL SUPPORT AND OBSERVANCE OF QUEZON CITY TO THE UNITED NATIONS (UN) GLOBAL ROAD SAFETY WEEK AND CALLING FOR FULL IMPLEMENTATION OF ROAD SAFETY LAWS AND ORDINANCES.

WHEREAS, with reference to the 2015 Global Status Report on Road Safety of the World Health Organization (WHO), road traffic accidents claim more than 1.25 million people every year and injure as many as 50 million individuals, with 90% of the casualties occurring in low- and middle-income countries;

WHEREAS, the Metro Manila Traffic Accident Recording and Analysis System (MMARAS), which indicates that the total number of road crashes in Metro Manila indicates a rise from 90,258 in 2014 to 95,615 in 2015, and reaching a record high of 109,322 in 2016;

WHEREAS, in view of the scale of the road safety problem, United Nations General Assembly has launched the Decade of Action for Road Safety (2011-2020), a global framework guiding national-level action with the goal of reducing global road traffic deaths and injuries by 2020; *⌘*

WHEREAS, while the WHO notes some progress on the 6th year of the Decade of Action for Road Safety (2011-2020), it was noted that many countries still need to strengthen their road safety legislation;


WHEREAS, the UN Global Road Safety Week shall be observed whenever declared by the United Nations to reduce disability and death due to road crashes in Quezon City.

NOW, THEREFORE,




