RESOLUTION NO. SP **7244**, S-2017

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO EXTEND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE OF FIVE THOUSAND PESOS (PHP5,000.00) TO EACH OF THE SEVEN HUNDRED TWENTY-EIGHT (728) INFORMAL SETTLER FAMILIES (ISFs) LIVING ALONG AND ON TOP OF TANQUE CREEK AT NIA SITE, BARANGAY PINYAHAN, QUEZON CITY, WHO ARE ABOUT TO BE RELOCATED TO NHA RESETTLEMENT SITES, EQUIVALENT TO A TOTAL AMOUNT OF THREE MILLION SIX HUNDRED FORTY THOUSAND PESOS (PHP3,640,000.00).

WHEREAS, a total of 728 informal settler families (ISFs) were verified to be living along and on top of Tanque Creek at NIA Site, Bgy. Pinyahan, Quezon City, which group of ISFs will be affected by the recovery of Tanque creek/clearing of waterways;

WHEREAS, to implement the recovery of Tanque Creek/clearing of waterways, there is a need to relocate the 728 affected ISFs to any of the available resettlement sites of the National Housing Authority (NHA);

WHEREAS, to draw cooperation from the affected ISFs and also to provide them with something to start with at the resettlement site, there is a need for the Quezon City Government to allocate and extend financial assistance fund to the 728 affected ISFs in the total amount of Php3,640,000.00 or an equivalent amount of Php5,000.00 per affected ISF;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455 (b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, states that, "the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations, and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance".


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, to extend financial assistance of Five Thousand Pesos (Php5,000.00) to each of the Seven Hundred Twenty-Eight (728) informal settler families (ISFs) living along and on top of Tanque Creek at NIA Site, Barangay Pinyahan, Quezon City, who are about to be relocated to NHA Resettlement Sites, equivalent to a total amount of Three Million Six Hundred Forty Thousand Pesos (Php3,640,000.00).


