WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No 7160, otherwise known as the General Welfare Clause of the Local Government Code of 1991, provides, among others, that every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers, necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare;

WHEREAS, under the same Code, the City Council has the authority to enact ordinances, granting franchise and the issuance of permits or licenses, and levying taxes, fees and charges;

WHEREAS, the Philippine Society for Microbiology and Infectious Diseases, Inc. or PSMID is the country's leading professional association of specialists in infectious diseases and microbiology;


WHEREAS, PSMID's vision is to be a globally-recognized and respected leader and Authority dedicated to saving lives and reducing the burden of infectious disease in the country;
