WHEREAS, the government shall pursue an intensified and unrelenting campaign against illegal drugs and shall endeavour to see the assistance of the local government units in drug clearing operations:

WHEREAS, according to Philippine Drug Enforcement Agency (PDEA) Director General Aaron Aquino, 289 barangay officials are included in the narcolist of President Rodrigo R. Durterte which are composed of 143 punong barangays and 146 barangay kagawads, of this number, 207 officials are still believed to be active in the illegal drug trade;

WHEREAS, in support of President Rodrigo R. Durterte's thrust against illegal drugs, it is imperative that those who have the desire to be barangay officials must be drug free;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government is in the forefront in the eradication of illegal drugs campaign of the current administration.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to encourage, as it does hereby encourage all Candidates for Barangay and Sangguniang Kabataan Elections in Quezon City to take the initiative to undergo drug testing and encourage them to include as an integral part of their campaign platform the anti-illegal drug campaign of the city.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to furnish the Quezon City Barangay and Community Relations Department a copy of this resolution for dissemination to all 142 barangays for their information and guidance.
