RESOLUTION NO. SP- **7446**, S-2018

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT, THROUGH THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO PURCHASE TWELVE (12) UNITS OF MOTOR VEHICLES AMOUNTING TO SIXTEEN MILLION TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (PHP16,200,000.00) TO BE CHARGED AGAINST THE AVAILABLE FUNDS OF THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR AND TO BE DISTRIBUTED TO THE VARIOUS BARANGAYS OF THE 6TH LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT OF QUEZON CITY INTENDED FOR MOBILITY IN THE MONITORING OF PROGRAMS AND PROJECTS AND FOR IMPROVING THE SERVICE, PRODUCTIVITY AND EFFICIENCY AND TO TRANSFER THE OWNERSHIP OF THE SAID VEHICLES TO THE RECIPIENTS WITHOUT COST.

WHEREAS, the cost of the above stated vehicle is One Million Three Hundred Fifty Thousand Pesos (Php1,350,000.00) per unit and the total amount of the twelve (12) vehicles is Sixteen Million Two Hundred Thousand Pesos (Php16,200,000.00);

WHEREAS, pursuant to Administrative Order No. 1, amending Administrative Order No. 233, Series of 2008, the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista has already sought permission and authorization from the DILG in his letter addressed to DILG Assistant Regional Director and Concurrently Quezon City Director Juan Jovian E. Inginiero, CESO IV, for acquisition of the above-described motor vehicles, which amount is included in the 2018 Annual Budget of the City Government;


WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455 (b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991" the City Mayor, as the Chief Executive of the City Government, shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations, and such other documents upon the authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance;

WHEREAS, a Deed of Donation will be given to the beneficiaries transferring the ownership, encumbrances, and dues of the said vehicles and in so doing authorizing them to appropriate funds from their respective budgets for the maintenance and registration of the said vehicles.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize the Quezon City Government, through the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, to purchase twelve (12) units of motor vehicles amounting to Sixteen Million Two Hundred Thousand Pesos (Php16,200,000.00) to be charged against the available funds of the Office of the City Mayor and to be distributed to the various barangays of the 6th Legislative District of Quezon City intended for mobility in the monitoring of programs and projects and for improving the service, productivity and efficiency and to transfer the ownership of the said vehicles to the recipients without cost.


