"It is hereby declared to be the policy of the State to promote peace and order, ensure public safety and further strengthen local government capability aimed towards the effective delivery of the basic services to the citizenry through the establishment of a highly efficient and competent police force that is national in scope and civilian in character. Towards this end, the State shall bolster a system of coordination and cooperation among the citizenry, local executives and the integrated law enforcement and public safety agencies created under this Act".

WHEREAS, in the survey conducted by the National Police Commission (NAPOLCOM) last October 30, November 2, 3 and November 6 to 10, 2017, the Quezon City Police District (QCPD) placed first among other police districts as "Most Trusted Police District" in Metro Manila;

WHEREAS, the QCPD garnered the highest ratings in terms of respect and trust from the public, quality of police response and accessibility, moral and ethics, level of safety, crime reporting and of public support;

WHEREAS, this would not be made possible without the collaborative efforts and sacrifices of all our courageous and dedicated men in uniform of the QCPD under the competent leadership of then QCPD Director and now NCRPO Regional Director, Chief Superintendent Guillermo Eleazar, the Quezon City Government and the community;

WHEREAS, the positive result of the said survey had given our people the concrete justification to trust our law enforcement agency once again, thus, uplifting the morale of our law enforcers. ✕


