A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE CONTRACTS ENTERED INTO BY THE CITY MAYOR WITH THE WINNING BIDDERS FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF VARIOUS INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS (PROJECT NO. 18-6001 TO 18-6008, 18-7001 TO 18-7004, AND 18-7006 TO 18-7009) IN QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160 expressly states that "Every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare";

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 expressly states that a resolution shall first be passed/approved by the concerned Sanggunian before the local chief executive can enter into agreement with private entity;


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


