WHEREAS, the Philippine Youth Games - Batang Pinoy or simply Batang Pinoy is the national youth sports competition of the Philippines for athletes under 15 years old, unlike the Palarong Pambansa which is a competition for student athletes, the Batang Pinoy also includes the out-of-school youth;

WHEREAS, the Batang Pinoy was established through the Executive Order No. 44 which was issued by then President Joseph Estrada on December 2, 1998, serves as the national sports program for children envisioned to address the need for a comprehensive grassroots sports program centered on values formation inherent in the practice of sports and fair play; ✕

WHEREAS, the Batang Pinoy was organized in partnership with the Department of Education (DepEd), Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) and the League of Provinces, Cities, Municipalities and Barangays;

WHEREAS, the 2018 Batang Pinoy National Championships was held in Baguio City on September 17 to 22, 2018;

WHEREAS, a total of twenty-seven (27) sports were contested including archery, arnis, athletics, badminton, baseball, basketball, boxing, chess, Dancesports, karatedo, lawn tennis, Pencak Silat, sepak takraw, softball, swimming, table tennis, taekwondo, volleyball (indoor and beach), cycling, futsal, gymnastics, judo, Muay Thai, triathlon, Weightlifting, wrestling and wushu;

WHEREAS, forty-nine (49) Quezon City athletes in fourteen (14) sport disciplines earned thirty-two (32) gold medals, seventeen (17) silver medals and nineteen (19) bronze medals, and was ranked fourth overall among one hundred ninety (190) local government units;

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper for the Quezon City Government to recognize and commend the hard work and determination of Quezon City athletes who brought honor to the City in the recently concluded 2018 Batang Pinoy National Championships.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to extend, as it does hereby extend the sincerest congratulations and commendation of the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. 


