WHEREAS, it is the State policy to encourage sports programs, league competitions, and amateur sports, including training for international competitions, to foster self-discipline, teamwork and excellence for the development of a healthy and alert citizenry;

WHEREAS, the Philippine Women's National Football Team qualified in the 2023 FIFA Women's World Cup, the highest level of football competition for national teams, their first, after reaching the semifinals of the 2022 AFC Women's Asian Cup, also for the first time, in February 2022;

WHEREAS, the Philippines hosted the 2022 ASEAN Football Federation (AFF) Women's Championship, the premiere competition for national women's team of countries in the ASEAN region, from July 4 to 17, 2022, and with a record number of participating teams;

WHEREAS, the Philippine Women's National Football Team demonstrated perseverance and tenacity to win the competition's semifinals and finals against regional powerhouse Vietnam and Thailand with a score of 4-0 and 3-0 respectively, eventually annexing the AFF Women's Championship for the first time in the country's football history;


WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper for the Quezon City Government to congratulate and commend the hard work, excellence and sportsmanship of the Philippine Women's National Football Team as they bring honor and pride to the Philippines, worthy of emulation and inspiration for all Filipinos.
