Jumawan, Master Teacher, who served as one of the directors of the two films; Ms. Erlinda Paras, Teacher, who was an actress in the two films; and Ms. Ariane Kristhia Rosauero, former student, who was an actress in "Dear Mama";

WHEREAS, Mr. Jek Jumawan garnered other awards for the mentioned films from international film competitions such as the Countries International Film Fest (India), Silver Award for Best Actor in the Aguila International Film Festival (Cebu), Best Supporting Actor in the Five Continents International Film Festival (Venezuela), and Best Supporting Actor in the World Film Carnival (Singapore) among many others;

WHEREAS, Ms. Erlinda Paras was awarded as Best Supporting Actress in 195 Countries International Film Festival (India), and Best Supporting Actress and Gold Award in the Aguila International Film Festival (Cebu);

WHEREAS, Ms. Ariane Kristhia Rosauero was awarded as Best Actress in the Sweden Film Awards, Best Actress in the 195 Countries International Film Festival (India), and Best Actress and Gold Award in the Award in the Aguila International Film Festival (Cebu);

WHEREAS, these serve as an inspiration for aspiring film makers in creating quality films and sharing the talent and stories of Filipinos to the world.


