A RESOLUTION STRONGLY URGING THE CITY GOVERNMENT TO PROVIDE LITERACY AND NUMERACY WORKBOOKS FOR THE IDENTIFIED GRADE LEVELS BASED ON RESULTS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION SCHOOLS DIVISION OFFICE OF QUEZON CITY (SDO-QC) ASSESSMENTS.

WHEREAS, Section 1, Article XIV of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that "The State shall protect and promote the right of all citizens to quality education at all levels, and shall take appropriate steps to make such education accessible to all";

WHEREAS, the Schools Division Office of Quezon City (SDO QC) conducted the Comprehensive Rapid Literacy Assessment (CRLA) and the Albay Numeracy Assessment Test (Al NAT) last School Year (SY) 2021-2022 for Grades 1 to 3 pupils to assess their readiness to the succeeding grade levels;

WHEREAS, among the 109,052 learners assessed in CRLA, 29% of Grades 1 to 3 pupils needed reading remediation in Filipino, while Al NAT results revealed that 71% out of 106,394 learners needed remediation in numeracy;

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic brought about challenges and sudden changes in the education system, these include the Grades 1 to 3 pupils who were then entering their first stage of learning during SY 2020-2021;

WHEREAS, as the learners moved to Grades 2 to 4, there is a need to provide them appropriate workbooks, especially for remediation in Filipino and numeracy, to support their learning.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to strongly urge, as it does hereby strongly urge, the City Government to provide literacy and numeracy workbooks for the identified grade levels based on results of the Department of Education Schools Division Office of Quezon City (SDO-QC) Assessments.


