A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH HIGHER EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS (HEIs) NAMELY, UNIVERSITY OF SANTO TOMAS, ANGELES UNIVERSITY FOUNDATION, AND UNIVERSITY OF THE EAST - RAMON MAGSAYSAY MEMORIAL MEDICAL CENTER, INC., FOR THE PARTICIPATION IN THE CITY'S INCLUSIVE HEALTH PROGRAM FOR CHILDREN WITH DISABILITIES THROUGH SERVICE-LEARNING PROGRAM AT THE QUEZON CITY KABAHAGI CENTER FOR CHILDREN WITH DISABILITIES.

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government envisions to be a model of effective governance and responsible leadership, working in partnership with the citizenry in building a Quality Community and has a mission to provide quality service which will make Quezon City an ideal community where people live, work and do business in a hospitable, progressive and peaceful environment;

WHEREAS, Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-2617, S-2017, as amended by Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-2718, S-2018, established a Center for Children with Disabilities, known as Kabahagi Center for Children with Disabilities ("Kabahagi Center"), with the objective of strengthening the City's efforts for children who are disabled, impaired, handicapped, and in need of special education, as well as to provide services for rehabilitation;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Kabahagi Center for Children with Disabilities envisions a city that is inclusive, sustainable, empowering, and participatory where Persons with Disabilities have equal access to opportunities, rights, and privileges. It recognizes the rights of all children through its commitment to improving their quality of life through community empowerment, provision of services, and creation of equal access to health, educational, livelihood, and social opportunities;


WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government, through the Quezon City Kabahagi Center for Children with Disabilities and the educational institutions will maintain close coordination in order to achieve and complete their mutual objective of ensuring attainment of their defined goals, through Service Learning, in the conduct of research and information education campaign materials and facilitation of forums and/or similar activities, that will equally benefit the students and the community, the families, and children with disabilities under the Kabahagi Center;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Kabahagi Center for Children with Disabilities has experienced successful partnership with the Higher Education Institutions that it has partnered with in the previous year. The collaboration has led to increased efficiency of therapy services brought about by the added human resources;

WHEREAS, the Higher Education Institutions like the University of Santo Tomas, Angeles University Foundation, and University of the East – Ramon Magsaysay Memorial Medical Center, Inc., will assign student interns (Occupational Therapy, Speech-Language Pathology, Physical Therapy, Prosthesis and Orthosis Program) to the QC Kabahagi Center, through Service Learning Program, that will be carried out through a hybrid training, i.e., telehealth and face-to-face with the clinical supervisors designated by the QC Kabahagi Center providing telesupervision and on-site supervision, among others;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455 (b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations and such other documents upon the authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance.




NOW, THEREFORE,


