BELMONTE, TO ENTER INTO A TRIPARTITE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE PHILIPPINE STATISTICS AUTHORITY (PSA) AND THE DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT (DILG), FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE COMMUNITY-BASED MONITORING SYSTEM (CBMS) IN QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, the Philippine Statistics Authority shall be the lead agency in the implementation of the CBMS pursuant to Republic Act No. 11315, otherwise known as the CBMS Act;

WHEREAS, Rule VI, Section 7 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of the CBMS Act tasked the Department of the Interior and Local Government to develop and implement information and education campaign relating to CBMS; ensure compliance of the LGUs in the various CBMS activities; and extend assistance to the Philippine Statistics Authority in the conduct and implementation of the CBMS;

WHEREAS, Section 4 of the CBMS provides that the Local Government Unit is the primary data collecting authority within its locality;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government is mandated to collaborate with the PSA and DILG to implement the CBMS in their locality synchronous with the 2022 CBMS Nationwide Rollout;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government has allocated an amount of One Hundred Sixty-Nine Million Nine Hundred Thousand Three Hundred Eighty-One Pesos (Php169,900,381.00) to shoulder the major financial requirements for the CBMS operations in Quezon City;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455 (b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations and such other documents upon the authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, to enter into a Tripartite Memorandum of Agreement with the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) and the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), for the implementation of the Community-Based Monitoring System (CBMS) in Quezon City.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that a copy of the subject Tripartite Memorandum of Agreement, with Annexes, shall form an integral part of this Resolution.
