A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A CERTIFICATE OF EXCEPTION TO SYCWIN COATING AND WIRES, INC./MICHAEL T. SY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF A PAINT MANUFACTURING PLANT CONSISTING OF ONE (1)-STOREY WAREHOUSE WITH MEZZANINE (AS BUILT) LOCATED AT LOT 9-A, NO. 135 JOY STREET, GRACE VILLAGE, BARANGAY BALINGASA, DISTRICT I, QUEZON CITY, ALLOWING DEVIATION FROM THE RESTRICTIONS PROVIDED UNDER ORDINANCE NO. SP-2502, S-2016, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE COMPREHENSIVE ZONING ORDINANCE OF 2016.

WHEREAS, SYCWIN Coating and Wires, Inc./Michael T. Sy is applying for the issuance of a Certificate of Exception for the construction and operation of a Paint Manufacturing Plant consisting of One (1)-Storey Warehouse with Mezzanine (As Built) Located at Lot 9-A, No. 135 Joy Street, Grace Village, Barangay Balingasa, District I, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Paragraph 2, Section 55, Article VIII of Ordinance No. SP-2502, S-2016, an Exception is required for the aforesaid project upon authorization from the City Council;

WHEREAS, the proposed project will not adversely affect public health, safety and welfare and is in keeping with the general pattern of development in the community;

WHEREAS, the proposed project will support economic-based activities and provide livelihood, vital community services and facilities and at the same time, poses no adverse effect on the zone classification of the community;

WHEREAS, the exception will not adversely affect the appropriate use of the adjoining property in the same district;

WHEREAS, the exception will not alter the essential character and general purpose of the district where the exception sought is located;

WHEREAS, the applicant has complied with all the necessary requirements prescribed by law, ordinance or administrative issuances;

WHEREAS, the applicant has submitted the necessary and mandatory requirements in support of the proposed project and undertakes to comply with the provisions of existing laws, ordinances, and rules and regulations pertaining to public safety, environmental protection, and vehicular traffic.
