A RESOLUTION RENEWING THE SPECIAL PERMIT OF PHILIPPINES IVISION INCORPORATED TO OPERATE AN ELECTRONIC GAMES (E-GAMES) ESTABLISHMENT AT 2ND FLOOR, PWESTO COMMUNITY MALL, NO. 56 HOLY SPIRIT DRIVE, BARANGAY HOLY SPIRIT, DISTRICT II, QUEZON CITY, SUBJECT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS PROMULGATED BY THE PHILIPPINE AMUSEMENT AND GAMING CORPORATION (PAGCOR)

WHEREAS, Philippines Ivision Incorporated is a domestic corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of Philippine laws located at 2nd Floor, Pwesto Community Mall, No. 56 Holy Spirit Drive, Barangay Holy Spirit, District II, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, the applicant was previously granted a Special Permit by the Quezon City Council for the operation of an Electronic Games (E-Games) establishment through Resolution No. SP-7778, S-2019;

WHEREAS, to enable the applicant to continue its business operations, there is a need to renew its Special Permit pursuant to an existing City ordinance;

WHEREAS, the operation of an E-Games establishment is regulated and licensed by the Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corporation (PAGCOR);

WHEREAS, the aforementioned business activity will provide employment and additional revenue to the City Government;

WHEREAS, Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-2773, S-2018, as amended, and Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, authorize the City Council to grant or renew a Special Permit to business activities of the same nature.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to renew, as it does hereby renew, the Special Permit of Philippines Ivision Incorporated to operate an Electronic Games (E-Games) establishment at 2nd Floor, Pwesto Community Mall, No. 56 Holy Spirit Drive, Barangay Holy Spirit, District II, Quezon City, subject to the rules and regulations promulgated by the Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corporation (PAGCOR).

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the authority to operate an E-Games establishment granted herein shall be subject to the following conditions:

1. The holding of E-Games shall be in accordance with the rules and regulations promulgated by PAGCOR;
2. The operation of an E-Games establishment shall not include playing of games not related to or other than E-Games;
3. The operation is enjoined to prohibit from playing the abovementioned games in its gaming site individuals below twenty-one (21) years of age or students of any school, college or university;
4. Philippines Ivision Incorporated shall remit to the City Treasurer a license fee of three percent (3%) of the gross receipt of herein grantee, which shall be made payable yearly to the City Treasurer during the lifetime of this Resolution in accordance with Section 25 of Ordinance No. SP-2773, S-2018, as amended; and


