ORDINANCE NO. SP. 2221 , S-2012

AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING ONE WAY TRAFFIC SCHEME ALONG MANINGNING EXTENSION CORNER MATAHIMIK STREET AND CORNER V. LUNA EXTENSION, BARANGAY MALAYA, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

WHEREAS, Section 458 (a) (5) (v) and (vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as "The Local Government Code of 1991", provides for the Powers, Duties, Functions of the Sangguniang Panlungsod:

"(v) Regulate the use of streets, avenues, alleys, sidewalks, bridges, parks and other public places and approve the construction, improvement, repair and maintenance of the same, xxx," /

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(vi) Regulate traffic on all streets and bridges; prohibit encroachments or obstacles thereon and, when necessary in the interest of public welfare, xxx."

WHEREAS, the Barangay Council of Barangay Sacred Heart passed Resolution No.- 91, Series of 2011, entitled:

"A resolution requesting the City Council through Councilor Jesus Suntay to approve the implementation of One Way along Maningning Ext. corner Matahimik St. (Entry Point) and corner V. Luna Ext. (Exit Point) of Barangay Malaya, District IV, Quezon City and prescribing penalties for violation thereof";

WHEREAS, the barangay experiences massive complaints due to the continuous problem of vehicular traffic on a daily basis;

WHEREAS, there is a need to implement a one-way traffic scheme along certain streets of Barangay Malaya to restore order and discipline within the area;

WHEREAS, it is incumbent upon the City Government to regulate the traffic situation and road conditions within its jurisdiction.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. TITLE. - This Ordinance shall be known and referred to as "ONE-WAY TRAFFIC SCHEME OF BARANGAY MALAYA".

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SECTION 2. STREETS COVERED. - The following streets are considered as one-way:

- a) Maningning Extension corner Matahimik Street (entry point)
- b) Corner V. Luna (exit point)

SECTION 3. ENFORCEMENT. - This Ordinance shall be enforced and implemented by the Department of Public Order and Safety (DPOS) and by the Barangay Public Security Officer (BPSO) of Barangay Malaya.

SECTION 4. INSTALLATION OF ONE-WAY TRAFFIC SCHEME. – The Department of Public Order and Safety (DPOS) is hereby mandated to install a Traffic Sign indicating that the street is one way to inform motorists, drivers, vehicle owners and the public in general.

SECTION 5. PENALTIES. — Any person or persons found violating the provision/s of this Ordinance shall be penalized with a fine of not less than One Thousand Pesos (Php 1,000.00) but not for than Five Thousand Pesos (Php 5,000.00).

SECTION 6. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. - If, for any reason or reasons, any part or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 7. REPEALING CLAUSE. – All existing ordinance and resolutions, local executive orders, rules and regulations inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Ordinance is hereby repealed and/or modified accordingly.

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SECTION 8. EFFECTIVITY. — This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval,
