AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE M. AQUINO HEALTH CENTER TO BE ESTABLISHED AS A SUPER HEALTH CENTER IN DISTRICT VI, QUEZON CITY AND FOR OTHER RELATED PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, health center facilities are vital component of local government units in the delivery of basic health services for common diseases, maternal and child health care and other basic health services including health education and information to the needy residents;

WHEREAS, the delivery of the most basic health services will be most effective if a particular area has a super health center which has a more extensive health services than an

WHEREAS, the residents of District VI can readily and effectively avail of more extensive health services if a super health center is located within the area.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

Section 1. M. Aquino Health Center is hereby established as a Super Health Center in District VI, Quezon City under the operational jurisdiction of the Quezon City Health Department.

Section 2. The Engineering Department in coordination with the Quezon City Health Department shall determine the infrastructural requirements for the conversion of the existing Health Center in District VI into a Super Health Center.

Section 3. The Capital Outlay for the Infrastructures and Medical Equipment necessary for the conversion of the existing Health Center in District VI into a super health center shall be included in the next Annual Budget of Quezon City following the approval of this Ordinance.

Section 4. The Quezon City Health Department shall assign the necessary medical, operational and administrative personnel of the Super Health Center from the existing personnel of the Quezon City Health Department. If necessary, the Quezon City Health Department shall recommend to the City Mayor and the Quezon City Council the creation of additional medical, operational and/or administrative personnel.



Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.


